# **Emmaus Borough Trash & Recycling Information**

#### TRASH COLLECTION

Collection will occur once a week on Wednesdays. Put your cans out the night before. There is a five (5) can limit per household. Bulk items like furniture, mattresses, etc. are picked up Wednesday. White goods (washer, dryers, etc.) need to be scheduled by calling J.P. Mascaro & Sons. Items that contain freon must have freon removed with certified sticker. Household construction is limited to 70lbs.

## **A RECYCLING COLLECTION**

Collection will occur once a week on Wednesdays. Single Stream Recycling—The Borough adopted an expanded list of recyclables that will no longer need to be separated. You can simply use a regular garbage can and mark it as "recycling" (recycling stickers are available at Town Hall). and place all recyclable items into the same can. All of the recyclables are commingled, so that you do not need to separate the items.

### **♦ WHAT TO RECYCLE?**

- · Aluminum food and beverage containers
- Glass food and beverage containers (brown, clear, or green)
- · Ferrous (Iron) cans
- PET plastic containers with the symbol #1 with screw tops only, without caps
- HDPE natural plastic containers with the symbol #2 narrow neck containers only (milk and water bottles
- HDPE pigmented plastic containers with the symbol #2 narrow neck containers only, without caps (detergent, shampoo bottles, etc.)
