9/19/10: The Emmaus Police Department investigates an underage drinking incident at the Emmaus High School football game involving a 16 year old female EHS student, who is cited for Underage Drinking. The investigation reveals that 21 year old Coty L. Peoples, of 523 Ridge St., Emmaus, supplied the alcohol and on 9/22/10, he is consequentially charged with Furnishing Alcohol to a Minor and is detained in Lehigh County Prison on a probation violation. On 9/23/10 a 16 year old male is detained by Lehigh County Juvenile Probation after he is charged by the Emmaus Police Department with Intimidation of a Witness, Terroristic Threats and Harassment after allegedly posting threats on Facebook that were directed at a witness in the case against Peoples.

9/27/10: Arrested: Robert W. Schlott, 41, of 166 Main St., Apt 1, Emmaus, for DUI (on a bicycle) in the 100 block of Green St.. Schlott was processed at the Lehigh County DUI Center and released.

9/28/10: Cited and released: A 16 year old, female, Emmaus High School student for Possessing Tobacco at the School.

9/29/10: Cited: Theodore Deppe, 48, of 627 Furnace St., Emmaus, for Harassment after a disturbance at his residence where Deppe allegedly pushed a female guest.
